#### **Class Management**

We use an online system called joinin.online. This system manages your payments, schedule, emergency contact details, communication, and much more. In order to access the online system, make payments, and check the timetable, you must activate your account either by making a purchase or clicking on the link in the invitation email. You will be asked to complete various forms, these are very important both for the safety of the attending young person and also so that we can monitor the makeup of our classes and clubs, which means we can apply for funding. This helps us to keep our prices as low as possible and open access, with unbeatable concession rates and over a third of our students attending for free. Thank you for taking the time to help us with this mission.

#### **Payments**

Payment is taken by Direct Debit through our payment provider, London & Zurich. Payment is taken monthly even during the school holidays, which helps to spread the cost into more manageable amounts across the year.

Concession rates are available to students from low income households and in various other circumstances. We operate the concession spaces on a 'honesty and self-certified' policy which means we leave it as an option at checkout and do not ask for proof.

Free places in our paid clubs are also available for those on certain benefits. The following qualify for a free place:

- Income-related Free School Meals
- Disability Allowance
- Universal Credit where the overall household income (including UC) is £25,500 or less
- Young Carer
- Looked After Child
- Independent living and in financial need

If joining one of the paid clubs on a free place, proof of the above will be required.

Parents/carers of students who attend either the Free Clubs (17th Scout Hut, Hollingdean, Crew Club, and West Blatchington) or have been given a free place (as above) and feel they are able to make a donation to help us continue providing free spaces can do so via Stripe. There are three ways you could donate: £5/month, £50/term, or a one-off donation.



#### **Cancelling your membership**

If we do not hear from you then we will assume that your young actor will be continuing each term and will therefore always hold their place.

We ask for two months' notice if for any reason you want to leave ThirdSpace Theatre. As we are always looking to improve our services we also ask the reason for leaving. Please contact info@thirdspacetheatre.co.uk if you would like to cancel and we will arrange that for you. Direct Debits must remain in place until the end of the notice period. If a Direct Debit is cancelled prematurely, you will be invoiced for the outstanding amount due.

#### Sign In

If your child is walking to and from class, then we need your permission. Please do not leave children unaccompanied outside of classes before the start of the session unless they have written permission. Please make all efforts to be punctual when collecting/dropping off your children. Your child will also need your permission if you wish for them to be able to leave the premises during breaks on their own.

#### <u>Attendance</u>

Your child is a part of a company of young actors. Every member is vital and has a unique voice. Therefore, to build continuity, trust, and togetherness, we highly recommend that your child attends all sessions. Similarly, if we are rehearsing for our Christmas or Summer shows then non-attendance can have implications on how involved your young actor is in the show. If for any reason, they cannot attend a session or performance then please do let us know in advance. Obviously, this does not apply to unexpected illness.

### **Workshop Leaders**

The safety of your children is paramount. All workshop leaders are highly experienced at working with children and we pride ourselves on the quality of our professional directing. All workshop leaders have an enhanced DBS check.
